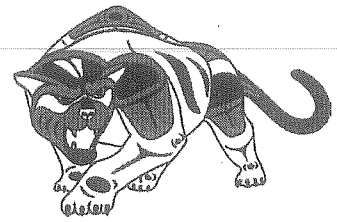

**Playground Installation:**

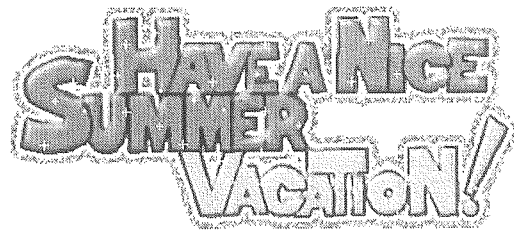

**Lost and Found:**

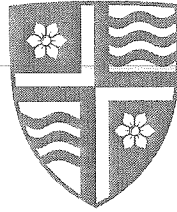

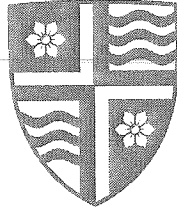

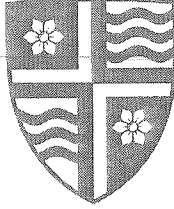
